- While web site addresses or URLs are no longer required by MLA format, most teachers still require them. Include them unless you are told otherwise.
- It is no longer necessary to credit Kenwood HS or BCPS for access to subscription databases.
- The medium of publication is listed in the citation (Web or Print.)
